

Pewee Division – Rules

1. Five runs constitute an inning. Last inning will be called by home plate umpire and may not be called prior to 7:50 pm. If inning is not complete by 8:00 pm the game will continue until the inning is complete.
2. Trappers may be worn by first baseman and/or catcher and only if they are playing these positions in the field.
3. Players may only pitch a maximum of four innings per game but does not have to be consecutive (i.e. if a pitcher pitches to a batter in an inning, it shall be considered as an inning pitched). Once a pitcher is removed, he/she cannot re-enter as a pitcher in that inning.
4. Players may not leave their bases until the pitcher has released the ball.
5. The batter may attempt to run to first base if the catcher misses the ball on the third strike, providing first base is not occupied. If there are two outs, the batter can still run regardless of whether or not the first base is occupied.
